Principal's Report

The Principal provided an update on:

<u>Hobart Dance Eisteddfod</u> - 140 Hutchins dancers participated in the educational sections at this event. In the Junior School section, the ELC and Year 3 Dance Troupe were awarded a Special Mention, Year 5 received a Highly Commended award, with Year 4 receiving 3rd place. In the Secondary School section (Years 7-10), the Middle School Troupe were awarded Highly Commended and in the College section (Years 11-12) the Senior Troupe were awarded 1st place.

<u>MUN</u> - Nine students from Years 10-12 recently travelled to St Paul's Co-Educational College in Hong Kong on a Model United Nations (MUN) international adventure. MUN simulates the United Nations and other international bodies, allowing student delegates to take on roles such as diplomats, ambassadors, journalists, NGO agents, renowned experts and government ministers. Two of our students, Archie Yarrow and Charlie Hugo (both Year 12), received the Most Outstanding Delegate and Best Speaker awards, respectively for the EU.

<u>Sailing</u> - Two Hutchins teams recently competed at the 2024 Australian Secondary Schools Team Sailing Championships, held in Goolwa, South Australia. Hutchins Magenta finished 8th overall, while Hutchins Black placed 3rd overall. Hutchins Black will now go on to represent Australia in the Interdominion Championships, to be held in Auckland in October.

<u>Hockey</u> - Hutchins First XI were victorious over Marist Regional College in the Statewide SATIS competition, 3 goals to 2.

National Representation:

Charles Boman (Year 12) recently competed in the Australian Schoolboys Rugby Championships on the Sunshine Coast, representing Combined States. Charlie was one of only two Tasmanian U18 players that have been selected to participate in these Championships.

Euan Bolton (Year 5) and Oscar Ramsay (Year 4) represented Australia in the Under 12's Futsal Viti Cup in Fiji. Australia won the competition overall.





Edward Huys (Year 11) has been selected in the U18 men's Australian Volleyball team and will travel to Japan to compete against nationally ranked Japanese high school teams.

<u>Study tour</u> - 12 Thai students have travelled to Tasmania as a part of a Study Tour program, comprising six students residing in Burbury House (the others at Collegiate) for three weeks. All students are participating in Middle School classes and activities.

7 Aug – Anniversary Service, St David's Cathedral, 7 August where 22 Year 12 students were presented with Anniversary Ties by Board Member, The Reverend John McQuillan ('06), who also had a wonderful inspirational message to share.
