

## **THE HUTCHINS SCHOOL** Congratulations to Years 11 and 12

I am delighted to share with you just a very small sample of the outstanding academic achievements of our Year 12 students in 2024. These exceptional results are testament to the students' efforts and discipline to their academic studies throughout the year, together with dedication of our highly skilled staff who encouraged, challenged, and supported each student to achieve their personal best.

The following seven students achieved an ATAR above 99, placing them in the top 1% of students in the state. Congratulations go to Archie Yarrow 99.85, James Baird 99.7, William Rumley 99.65, Cliff Giddings 99.4, Hamish Cheeseman 99.35, Oliver Fowler 99.35 and Lachlan Browne 99.15.

## Key achievements include:

- Median ATAR of 89.63, the second highest achieved at Hutchins since the introduction of ATARs in 2006.
- 14% of Year 12 ATAR eligible students achieved an ATAR above 98.
- 48% of Year 12 ATAR eligible students achieved an ATAR above 90.
- 28 students achieved an ATAR above 95.
- 11 students placed in the top 99 students in Tasmania.
- Hutchins students were listed 26 times for achieving the highest score possible in a pre-tertiary subject.
- Approximately 153 students completed Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses, from short VET courses through to Certificate III qualifications, in a wide range of training areas including information technology, construction, maritime operations, and hospitality.
- 92% of all Year 12 students obtained a Tasmanian Certificate of Education.


